The United States of America,

To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, In pursuance of the provisions of the Revised Statutes of the United States, Chapter Six, Title Thirty-two, and legislation supplemental thereto, there have been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States the Plat and Field Notes of Survey and the Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at **Sacramento, California** accompanied by other evidence whereby it appears that **The Iron Mountain Investment Company,**

has entered and paid for the **Highland lode mining claim,**

designated by the Surveyor General as **Survey No. 5449,** embracing a portion of Section **thirty-five** in Township **thirty-three north** of Range **six west** of the **Mount Diablo Meridian,** in the **Flat Creek Mining District,** **Shasta County, California,**

and bounded, described, and platted as follows: Beginning at corner No. 1, an iron pipe three feet long, two inches in diameter, marked H 1 5449, with mound of stone; identical with corner No. 1 of the Alice Fraction lode claim, Survey No. 4139; also identical with the west quarter corner of Section thirty-five in Township thirty-three north of Range six west of the Mount Diablo Meridian;

Thence, first course, north eighty-six degrees fifty-seven minutes thirty seconds east one hundred eighty-two and ninety-two-hundredths feet intersect line 4 - 1 of the Alta lode claim, Survey No. 4521, at north eighteen degrees forty-nine minutes fifty seconds west five hundred seventy and seventy-eight-hundredths feet from corner No. 4; three hundred feet to a point from which discovery bears south two degrees fifty-four minutes thirty seconds west eight hundred twenty-seven and thirty-four-

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hundredths feet distant; three hundred twelve and eighty-six-hundredths feet intersect line 1 - 2 of said Alta lode claim; five hundred seventy and six-tenths feet to corner No. 2, an iron pipe thirty inches long, two inches in diameter, marked H 2 5449 H L 1 4139; identical with corner No. 1 of the Harbor Light lode claim, Survey No. 4139; situate on line 4 - 1 of Survey No. 5447, the Midget lode claim, at north one degree forty-five minutes east one hundred sixty feet from corner No. 4;

Thence, second course, south one degree twenty-five minutes five seconds west forty-five and eighty-one-hundredths feet intersect line 1-2 of said Alta lode claim; one hundred sixty and three-hundredths feet intersect line 3 - 4 of said Survey No. 5447, at south eighty-six degrees seventeen minutes fifteen seconds east ninety-two-hundredths of a foot from corner No. 4; five hundred sixty-five and ninety-eight-hundredths feet intersect line 3 - 4 of said Alta lode claim and line 1 - 2 of the King lode claim, Survey No. 4521, at south eighty-eight degrees twenty-seven minutes twenty-eight seconds east one hundred eighty-eight and ninety-six-hundredths feet from corners Nos. 4 and 1, respectively; one thousand eighty-five and fifteen-hundredths feet intersect line 4 - 1 of said King lode claim at south eighteen degrees thirty-four minutes twenty seconds east five hundred fifty-two and eighty-six-hundredths feet from corner No. 1; one thousand one hundred twenty-four and six-tenths feet to corner No. 3, an iron pipe eighteen inches long, two inches in diameter, marked H 3 5449 M 3 5448, P 2 5446, in cement; identical with corner No. 3 of Survey No. 5448 the Mocop lode claim and corner No. 2 of Survey No. 5446, the Paradise lode claim;

Thence, third course, south eighty-six degrees fifty-seven minutes thirty seconds west six hundred feet to corner No. 4, an iron pipe

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thirty inches long, two inches in diameter, marked H 4 5449 & 2 5448;
identical with corner No. 2 of said Survey No. 5448;

Thence, fourth course, north two degrees fifty-four minutes
thirty seconds east one thousand one hundred twenty-seven and thirty-four-
hundredths feet to corner No. 1, the place of beginning;-expressly excepting
and excluding from these presents all that portion of the ground hereinbe-
fore described, embraced in said mining claims or Survey No. 5447 and said
King and Alta lode claims, Survey No. 4521; and said Alice Fraction lode
claim, Survey No. 4139, and also all that portion of the Highland vein or
lode, and of all veins, lodes, and ledges, throughout their entire depth,
the tops or apexes of which lie inside of such excluded ground; Survey
No. 5449 extending one thousand one hundred twenty-seven and thirty-four-
hundredths feet in length along said Highland vein or lode; the premises
herein granted, containing eight acres and nine hundred sixty-five thou-
sandths of an acre.

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NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore, pursuant to the laws aforesaid, hereby granted by the United States unto the said
The Iron Mountain Investment Company

the said mining premises hereinbefore described, and not expressly excepted from these presents, and all that portion of the said vein, lode, or ledge, and of all other veins, lodes, and ledges throughout their entire depth, the tops or apexes of which lie inside of the surface boundary lines of said granted premises in said survey extended downward vertically, although such veins, lodes, or ledges in their downward course may so far depart from a perpendicular as to extend outside the vertical side lines of said premises: Provided, That the right of possession to such outside parts of said veins, lodes, or ledges shall be confined to such portions thereof as lie between vertical planes drawn downward through the end lines of said survey so continued in their own direction that such planes will intersect such exterior parts of said veins, lodes, or ledges: And provided further, That nothing herein contained shall authorize the grantee herein to enter upon the surface of a claim owned or possessed by another.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said mining premises, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said grantee above named and to **its successors** and assigns forever; subject, nevertheless, to the above-mentioned and to the following conditions and stipulations:

FIRST. That the premises hereby granted shall be held subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local laws, customs, and decisions of the courts. And there is reserved from the lands hereby granted a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.

SECOND. That in the absence of necessary legislation by Congress, the Legislature of **California** may provide rules for working the mining claim or premises hereby granted, involving easements, drainage, and other necessary means to its complete development.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I, **Warren G. Harding,**

President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
