To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, In pursuance of the provisions of the Revised Statutes of the United States, Chapter Six, Title Thirty-two, and legislation supplemental thereto, there have been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States the Plat and Field Notes of Survey and the Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at **Sacramento, California,** accompanied by other evidence whereby it appears that **The Iron Mountain Investment Company**

has entered and paid for the **Kitchener lode mining claim,**

designated by the Surveyor General as **Survey No. 5823,** embracing a portion of **Sections one and two** in Township thirty-two north and **Section thirty-five** in Township thirty-three north, all in **Range six west** of the **Mount Diablo Meridian,** in the **Flat Creek Mining District, Shasta County, California,**

and bounded, described, and platted as follows: Beginning at **corner No. 1,** an iron pipe thirty inches long, one and one-half inches in diameter, with brass cap marked **K 1 5823,** from which the northwest corner of **Section one** in Township thirty-two north of **Range six west** of the **Mount Diablo Meridian,** bears north twenty-one degrees thirty-one minutes five seconds west five hundred ninety-six and twenty-four-hundredths feet distant;

Thence, first course, south sixty degrees four minutes west two hundred fifty-three and eighty-nine-hundredths feet intersect line 1 - 2 of the **Keystone lode claim Survey No. 3744,** at south twenty-six minutes west ninety and nine-tenths feet from corner No. 1; two hundred fifty-eight and thirty-two-hundredths feet intersect the west boundary of the northwest quarter of **Section one** in Township thirty-two north of **Range**

six west of the Mount Diablo Meridian; six hundred thirty-six feet to corner No. 2, an iron pipe thirty inches long, one and one-half inches in diameter, with brass cap marked K 2 5828 L L 2 K 7 3744; identical with corner No. 7 of said Keystone lode claim and corner No. 2 of the Last Link lode claim, Survey No. 3744; and from corner No. 7 corner No. 1 bears north forty-nine degrees forty-one minutes east four hundred thirty-five and two-tenths feet distant;

Thence, second course, north forty-nine degrees forty-three minutes twenty-three seconds west one thousand one hundred ninety and eighty-five-hundredths feet intersect line 5 - 1 of said Last Link lode claim, at south eighty-seven degrees twenty-four minutes fourteen seconds west four hundred fifty-two and sixty-four-hundredths feet from corner No. 1; one thousand two hundred ninety-six and three-tenths feet intersect line 2 - 3 of the Big Dipper lode claim, Survey No. 3744, at south twenty-seven degrees six minutes forty-two seconds east thirty-eight and seventy-seven hundredths feet from corner No. 2; one thousand three hundred forty-one and fifty-six-hundredths feet intersect line 1 - 2 of said Big Dipper lode claim, at south seventy-two degrees forty minutes west seventeen and sixty-five-hundredths feet from corner No. 2; one thousand four hundred ninety-four feet to corner No. 3, an iron pipe thirty inches long one and one-half inches in diameter, with brass cap marked K 3 - 5828;

Thence, third course, north sixty degrees four minutes east three hundred eighteen feet to a point from which discovery tunnel bears south forty-nine degrees forty-three minutes twenty-three seconds east two hundred sixty feet distant; six hundred sixteen and ninety-seven-hundredths feet intersect line 2 - 3 of Survey No. 4521, the Prescott lode claim, at north twenty-four degrees thirty-three minutes three seconds west two hundred eighty-seven and seventy-six-hundredths feet from corner No. 2; six hundred thirty-six feet to corner No. 4, an iron pipe thirty inches long, one and one-half inches in diameter, with brass cap marked K 4 5828;

Thence, fourth course, south forty-nine degrees forty-three minutes twenty-three seconds east three hundred forty and seventy-two-hundredths feet intersect line 1 - 2 of said Survey No. 4521, at north seventy-two degrees east one hundred sixty-four and ninety-five-hundredths feet from corner No. 2; one thousand two hundred three and seventy-one-hundredths feet intersect the west boundary of said northwest quarter of Section one; one thousand four hundred ninety-four feet to corner No. 1, the place of beginning;-expressly excepting and excluding from these presents all that portion of the ground hereinbefore described, embraced in said mining claim or Survey No. 4521; and said Keystone, Last Link, and Big Dipper lode claims, Survey No. 3744; and said northwest quarter of Section one, and also all that portion of the Kitchener vein or lode, and of all veins, lodes, and ledges, throughout their entire depth, the tops or apexes of which lie inside of such excluded ground; Survey No. 5820 extending one thousand four hundred ninety-four feet in length along said Kitchener vein or lode; the premises herein granted, containing fourteen acres and five hundred forty-seven thousandths of an acre.

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore, pursuant to the laws aforesaid, hereby granted by the United States unto the said **The Iron Mountain Investment Company**

the said mining premises hereinbefore described, and not expressly excepted from these presents, and all that portion of the said vein, lode, or ledge, and of all other veins, lodes, and ledges throughout their entire depth, the tops or apexes of which lie inside of the surface boundary lines of said granted premises in said survey extended downward vertically, although such veins, lodes, or ledges in their downward course may so far depart from a perpendicular as to extend outside the vertical side lines of said premises: Provided, That the right of possession to such outside parts of said veins, lodes, or ledges shall be confined to such portions thereof as lie between vertical planes drawn downward through the end lines of said survey so continued in their own direction that such planes will intersect such exterior parts of said veins, lodes, or ledges: And provided further, That nothing herein contained shall authorize the grantee herein to enter upon the surface of a claim owned or possessed by another.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said mining premises, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said grantee above named and to **its successors** and assigns forever; subject, nevertheless, to the above-mentioned and to the following conditions and stipulations:

FIRST. That the premises hereby granted shall be held subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local laws, customs, and decisions of the courts. And there is reserved from the lands hereby granted a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.

SECOND. That in the absence of necessary legislation by Congress, the Legislature of **California** may provide rules for working the mining claim or premises hereby granted, involving easements, drainage, and other necessary means to its complete development.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I, **Calvin Coolidge,**

President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
