To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, In pursuance of the provisions of the Revised Statutes of the United States, Chapter Six, Title Thirty-two, and legislation supplemental thereto, there have been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States the Plat and Field Notes of Survey and the Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at **Sacramento, California,** accompanied by other evidence whereby it appears that **The Iron Mountain Investment Company**

has entered and paid for the **Ole Hanson lode mining claim,**

designated by the Surveyor General as **Survey No. 5829, embracing a portion of Section thirty-five in Township thirty-three north and Section two in Township thirty-two north all in Range six west of the Mount Diablo Meridian, in the Flat Creek Mining District, Shasta County, California,**

and bounded, described, and platted as follows: Beginning **at corner No. 1, an iron pipe thirty inches long, one and one-half inches in diameter, with brass cap marked O H 1 5829, from which the north quarter corner to Section two in Township thirty-two north of Range six west of the Mount Diablo Meridian, bears north twenty-nine degrees fifty minutes thirty seconds west one hundred sixty-two and three-hundredths feet distant;**

Thence, first course, south eighty-six degrees thirty-two minutes four seconds west sixty and twenty-one-hundredths feet intersect line 7 - 1 of the Hidden Treasure lode claim, Survey No. 3744, at south thirteen degrees fifty minutes east eighty-four and twenty-seven-hundredths feet from corner No. 1; eighty-one and eighty-eight-hundredths feet intersect the east boundary of Lot three of Section two in Township thirty-two north of Range six west of the Mount Diablo Meridian, at

south twenty-six minutes west one hundred forty-five and five-tenths feet from the northeast corner; one thousand three hundred eighty-six and thirty-two-hundredths feet intersect the west boundary of said Lot three of Section two, at south twenty-six minutes west two hundred nineteen and twenty-one-hundredths feet from the northwest corner; one thousand five hundred feet to corner No. 2, an iron pipe thirty inches long, one and one-half inches in diameter, with brass cap marked O H 2 5829;

Thence, second course, north two degrees fifty-four minutes thirty seconds east six hundred feet to corner No. 3, an iron pipe thirty inches long, one and one-half inches in diameter, with brass cap marked O H 3 5829;

Thence, third course, north eighty-six degrees thirty-two minutes four seconds east one thousand two hundred eighty-one and fifty-four-hundredths feet intersect line 1 - 2 of the Great Eastern lode claim, Survey No. 3744, at north thirteen degrees fifty minutes west two hundred fifty-four and seventy-three-hundredths feet from corner No. 1; one thousand five hundred feet to corner No. 4, an iron pipe thirty inches long, one and one-half inches in diameter, with brass cap marked O H 4 5829;

Thence, fourth course, south two degrees fifty-four minutes thirty seconds west two hundred forty-one and forty-eight-hundredths feet intersect line 5 - 1 of said Great Eastern lode claim, also line 4 - 5 of said Hidden Treasure lode claim, at north eighty-two degrees twenty-three minutes east one hundred forty-six and nineteen-hundredths feet and one hundred eighty-two and nineteen-hundredths feet, respectively, from corners Nos. 1 and 4; and from corner No. 4 of said Hidden Treasure lode claim corner No. 3 bears south eighteen degrees fifty-two minutes, nineteen seconds east two hundred three and ninety-eight-hundredths feet distant; and from corner No. 3 corner No. 2 bears south eighty-eight degrees twenty-eight minutes east fifteen and eight-tenths feet distant; and

from corner No. 2 corner No. 1 bears south sixteen minutes east sixty-two and thirty-six-hundredths feet distant; three hundred feet to a point from which discovery bears south eighty-six degrees thirty-two minutes four seconds west three hundred thirty-two feet distant; six hundred feet to corner No. 1, the place of beginning;-expressly excepting and excluding from these presents all that portion of the ground hereinbefore described, embraced in said Great Eastern and Hidden Treasure lode claims Survey No. 3744; and said Lot three of Section two, and also all that portion of the Ole Hanson vein or lode, and of all veins, lodes, and ledges throughout their entire depth, the tops or apexes of which lie inside of such excluded ground; Survey No. 5829 extending one thousand five hundred feet in length along said Ole Hanson vein or lode; the premises herein granted, containing thirteen acres and one hundred twenty-four thousandths of an acre.

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore, pursuant to the laws aforesaid, hereby granted by the United States unto the said
The Iron Mountain Investment Company

the said mining premises hereinbefore described, and not expressly excepted from these presents, and all that portion of the said vein , lode , or ledge , and of all other veins, lodes, and ledges throughout their entire depth, the tops or apexes of which lie inside of the surface boundary lines of said granted premises in said survey extended downward vertically, although such veins, lodes, or ledges in their downward course may so far depart from a perpendicular as to extend outside the vertical side lines of said premises: Provided, That the right of possession to such outside parts of said veins, lodes, or ledges shall be confined to such portions thereof as lie between vertical planes drawn downward through the end lines of said survey so continued in their own direction that such planes will intersect such exterior parts of said veins, lodes, or ledges: And provided further, That nothing herein contained shall authorize the grantee herein to enter upon the surface of a claim owned or possessed by another.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said mining premises, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said grantee above named and to **its successors** and assigns forever; subject, nevertheless, to the above-mentioned and to the following conditions and stipulations:

FIRST. That the premises hereby granted shall be held subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local laws, customs, and decisions of the courts. And there is reserved from the lands hereby granted a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.

SECOND. That in the absence of necessary legislation by Congress, the Legislature of **California** may provide rules for working the mining claim or premises hereby granted, involving easements, drainage, and other necessary means to its complete development.
